### **Class 1.**

### **Class 2**

First of all the children had to measure and cut the material for their kites, then they had to measure and cut the spindles for the kite frame using handsaws. Finally, they made their kites look bright and colourful by decorating them with ribbons and tissue paper. When designing and making their kites, the children had to think carefully about the properties of the materials they were choosing to make sure they were solid but light. The kites look amazing and the children will be bringing them home to fly during half term.





### **Class 3**

Class 3 have enjoyed the sunshine this week; going outside for a variety of maths activities and to finish their newspaper reports. They completed their science investigations and have created posters to show what they have discovered. Year 6 have been practising their songs in readiness for their performance for the leaver's service in the cathedral at Gloucester.
